CONSENT TO USE IRS DATA

You and all your FAFSA contributors must consent to have their information linked to the IRS. Failure to provide consent will cause your FAFSA to be rejected.

REVIEW AND SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA

Indicate which schools you would like your FAFSA to be sent to. Double-check that all the information is accurate. You will be notified when your contributors have completed their sections of the form.
