The JIFI Program at Arundel Lodge provides family and community support for youth who are having difficulty interacting in school, with peers, in the community, and/or at home.

Services We Offer

- In-home family assessments
- Substance use disorder screening and referrals
- Educational and Special Education Advocacy
- Transportation to court and IEP meetings
- Locating community service opportunities
- Strength-based treatment plans (for court also)
- Case management and service navigation for families, including:
GED/vocational programs, individual and family counseling, self-help and support groups, medical services, medical insurance, job training, energy assistance, mental health wellness and treatment, parenting groups and seminars

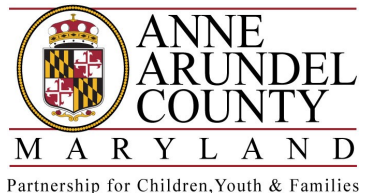


Who We Serve

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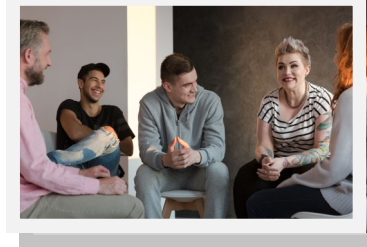


PEAK Program

- Trauma focused aggression management



Who We Serve

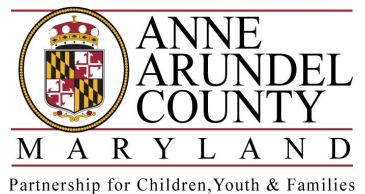
